

Attala County School District Virtual Learning Program

Board Approved 8/3/2020

A virtual learning option will be provided to students whose parents choose to opt out of the traditional face to face instructional program due to health concerns. Students participating in virtual learning will not be allowed to participate in extracurricular activities. The learning management systems used for virtual learning will be Google Classroom and/or Canvas. Web-based instructional programs such as i-Ready and USA Test Prep will be used as well. Instructional minutes for virtual learning will be a minimum of 240 minutes a day. Should the district or school(s) have to close due to an outbreak of COVID-19 cases, instruction will be delivered virtually to all students. Students who have COVID-19 related absences will be provided virtual learning as well. For students who do not have access to high-speed internet, assignments will be provided using other means such SchoolStatus, district email, take home learning packets, projects, etc. Special Education & English Language Learner services will be provided in accordance with applicable laws and guidelines. For Carnegie credit courses, the district will ensure mastery of content by completion of scheduled assignments and assessments with a final average of 65 or above. Attendance will be monitored by the learning management systems, Google Classroom and/or Canvas or day-to-day contact from the teacher along with student progress on daily assignments/established learning goals/assignment completion.
